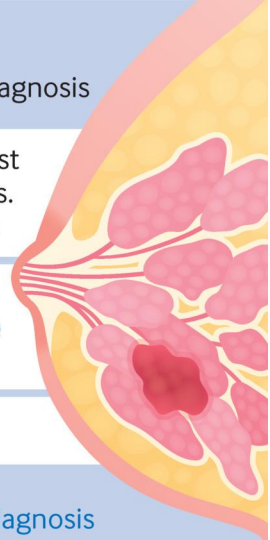




Breast cancer mortality

Risks following an early breast cancer diagnosis



Summary



The prognosis for women with early invasive breast cancer has improved substantially since the 1990s. Most can expect to be long term cancer survivors

Study design



Population based observational cohort study

All women in England with a diagnosis of **early invasive breast cancer, 1993-2015**

Population



512 447 women

Followed to December 2020

Variables

Calendar year of diagnosis

Age at diagnosis

Tumour grade

Tumour size

HER2 status*

Oestrogen receptor status

Cancer screen detected

Number of positive nodes

Breast cancer laterality

Index of multiple deprivation

Region of residence

* HER2 = human epidermal growth factor receptor 2
